














Spring Chinook Salmon

Pre-season Forecast – River Mouth Upriver Spring Chinook 254,100



March 15 Update 2005 Lower River Commercial Fishery

- □ Test fishing each Sunday (start 2/27)
- □ 4 Fisheries (3/1, 3/3, 3/8, 3/10) (+1)
- □ 970 chinook landed (31% upriver)
- □ 0.070% impact for upriver spring chinook (impact guideline = 0.6% with buffer)
- 0.064% impact for wild winter steelhead (impact guideline = 2.0%)
