At their meeting on October 12, the Anadromous Fish Advisory Committee (AFAC) determined it would be beneficial if the AFAC and the Members Advisory Group (MAG) became more familiar with the Hatchery Reform Project.

Hatchery Reform Project staff volunteered to give a workshop for this purpose. The workshop will include (1) a review of the tools being used by the project, (2) data and information procedures and management, and (3) some example programs. Tools include the Managing for Success model (formerly known as AHA).
