Middle and Upper Snake River Provinces Letter of Request for Additional Fish and Wildlife Funds - Neil Ward, CBFWA

The NWPPC's October 19, 2001, "Draft FY 2002 Start of Year Base Budget" document identifies the existence of only one ongoing project (i.e., 199201000) in the Upper Snake River Province for a total of \$175,366; however, an additional on-going project (i.e., 199505700) is also being implemented in this province at a cost of approximately \$2.6 million. In the NWPPC's October 12, 2001, "Allocation of Available Funds to Remaining Provinces for Fiscal Year 2002" memo, Doug Marker and Dan Warren identified a Draft Base Budget of \$803,442 for the Upper Snake River Province and subsequently applied their "formula" to identify the funds that would be allocated to the Upper Snake River Province. By using \$803,442 as the base budget, the amount that should have been identified for allocation was reduced by approximately \$700,000. As a result, the CBFWA members in the Upper Snake River Province request that CBFWA recommend to the NWPPC that an adjustment, which includes the full amount for the two projects, be made to correct the current funding allocation. In addition, the CBFWA Budget Workgroups (Workgroup) from the Middle and Upper Snake River Provinces request that the MMG review and approved the Workgroup's request for the allocation of additional funds from the Unallocated Reserve to supplement the existing allocations in the Middle and Upper Snake River provinces as well as the Columbia Cascade and Lower Columbia/Estuary provinces.
