	• The SPT's current FY11 allocation is \$18,000; however, they are requesting \$12,000 in additional funds to allow them to participate in the Resident Fish Advisory Committee (RFAC), Anadromous Fish Advisory Committee (AFAC), and other meetings of regional concern.
	• The USFWS did not request funding for FY11; however, they will require funding in the amount of \$6000 to participate in RFAC and other regional meetings. The USFWS will serve as Chair of the RFAC for 2011.
	• There is not a FY11 unallocated placeholder. In order to modify Member funding allocations, funds must either A) be transferred from other Members' allocations or B) requested through a Budget Oversight Group (BOG) within-year budget modification or reschedule request.
Recommended Action:	Review Members' current allocations to determine if these requests can be accommodated within the current overall Member funding allocation. Identify other potential needs among the Members. Determine a path forward for addressing these needs.
