ITEM 8: Review Talking Points Regarding Comments on Resident Fish, Data

Management, and Regional Coordination Category Review

At the February 15, 2012 MAG meeting, Tom Iverson provided a <u>presentation summarizing the ISRP's preliminary "Resident Fish, Data Management, and Regional Coordination Category Review"</u>.

Several members and staff are concerned and confused by the ISRP's comments and policy guidance requests.

The MAG decided not to respond to the ISRP questions, but to create talking points and possibly meet with Tony Grover and NPCC staff to ask what they plan to do with the ISRP's comments. The talking points identify the concerns that ISRP raised and the fish and wildlife managers' concerns with the review by the

ISRP.
