SUMMARY

The ad-hoc charter committee has taken the actions and discussions from the August 2&3 meeting and formulated strategies and actions to address the issues identified. This presentation is a summary of the committee's work with recommended strategies and action for consideration by the members.

August 2-3, 2005 Members Meeting Situation Facing Us Excerpts

•The CBFWA is fractured and not united

- •Communication is ineffective
- •There is a lack of consistency in participation
- •We need clear direction both internal and to staff

•There is rapidly changing operating situation – population, energy, global warming- but business continues as usual.

Current CBFWA structure and processes that contribute to this situation

•Only 2 members meetings per year that bring members together for discussions.

•Most communication occurs at the MMG level.

- •Actions formulated by MMG are sent out by consent mail.
- •No action on consent mail is a default yes.
- •Current perception that MMG is a policy body within CBFWA.

Strategies and actions to address

•Clarify roles of the committees as advisory with

- -Changes in the charter
- -Changes in organization chart
- -Development of one standing committee charter

•Have committee reports from the chairs as a standing item on all members meeting agendas and all members advisory group meeting agendas

•Role of CBFWA Executive Director and Staff shifts to proactive facilitation

-When all members are not present bring decision to them and seek their input

•Anticipate member changes

-Develop an orientation packet that is used to educate new members and staff.

-CBFWA staff will meet individually with new members and staff to educate on how CBFWA functions.

•Create a common understanding of consensus and how to achieve it through a "hands on" workshop
