
What We Are About

- Need reasoned, scientific approach to salmon recovery
 - Ensure fish benefits
 - Sensible solutions

- Electric costs affect everything economy, our fundamental way of life
- Multiple uses of rivers and hydro are critical to keeping region competitive
- Hydro provides unique benefits: renewable, no CO2, flexible operations
- We are NOT saying don't spend money
- We are saying spend wisely on salmon
- And, avoid costly approaches that provide little or few biological benefits

What We Stand For

- "Science-based, cost-effective" salmon recovery not just a catchy phrase
- Science/experience show us we can have a healthy economy and salmon
 - More salmon now than when Bonneville Dam built;
 - Fish passage survival at most dams is 90% 95%
 - Other improvements underway: RSW's
- Hydro can't do it alone: need comprehensive approach to reach recovery

Ongoing Efforts

- Continue tracking issues in BiOp
 - All issues still on the table in remand
 - October timeframe for new plan may be extended
- Weigh in on Council's Fish and Wildlife Program funding process
 - Recommendations by October to BPA for 2007-09 funding
- Continue to push for All "H" approach to salmon recovery
- Work collaboratively with regional coalition/other groups – including CBFWA!
