	The group agreed to work from draft version two submitted by Tony Nigro, ODFW. They revised the first paragraph, last sentence which originally read: "Upon further reflection on two statements in the second paragraph of the above referenced letter, the Members of CBFWA provide these additional points:" to "Upon further reflection on two statements in the second paragraph of the above referenced letter, the Members of CBFWA provide the following modifications to those two statements:".	

	In the third paragraph, under item two, the reference to "(letter attached)" was deleted. At this time CBFWA does not have a copy of the findings in the FPCOB's audit of the FPC operations that was submitted to the NPCC in the February 2003 Mainstem Amendment process. Brian Lipscomb stated that John Shurts, NPCC said he has a copy and would send it to CBFWA.
