Summary of Proposed Changes to the Endangered Species Act

- In August 2008, the George W. Bush administration proposed a
 regulatory overhaul that would bypass Congress and dramatically
 weaken the ESA by allowing federal agencies to determine whether
 projects such as highways, dams, mines, etc., will negatively affect
 endangered species, rather than following the regular protocol of
 seeking independent reviews.
