ITEM 5: CBFWA Charter Revision

In February 2012, the MAG will address the changing charter as it is associated with the new membership structure. Doug Taki confirmed with Jann Eckman that a revised CBFWA Charter will need to be prepared to address the verbal withdrawal notices from the Members who may leave the organization at the end of the contract year, March 31, 2012. The CBFWA formal membership withdrawal notices are due by March 1, 2012. The revised charter will need Members approval by April 1, 2012. The MAG directed CBFWA staff to begin working on the charter revisions with Joe Mentor, Mentor Law Group, PLLC and prepare a revised draft for review at the Feb. 14, 2012 MAG meeting.

ITEM 6: Next Members Meeting

The next Members meeting will be held in March to approve the revised Charter, elect a new Chair and Vice-chair, and review accomplishments from the past year.
