ITEM 4: Alignment of CBFWA Work Plan and NPCC Monitoring, Evaluation,
Research and Reporting Plan - Iverson

(~30 min) Research and Reporting Plan - Iverson

With the development of the MERR Plan, the NPCC has identified a framework for monitoring and reporting for the Fish and Wildlife Program. The restructured 2010 CBFWA work plan places an explicit emphasis on coordinated basinwide assessments for fish and wildlife. Tom will review the CBFWA work plan and the latest iteration of the MERR and describe how CBFWA is well positioned to assist the NPCC in development the Wildlife Monitoring Implementation Strategy (WMIS).

ITEM 5: Wildlife Monitoring Strategy Organization and Structure – Soults

(~30 min) Outline workshop strategy and expectations building from previous work on developing a wildlife monitoring strategy. Organization and structure of WMIS (needed outcomes), timelines/deadlines and additional needs. Moreover, how does language in June WMIS work and where does MERR document provide areas that should/should not be incorporated into WMIS.

The topics we will address at today's workshop include the **highlighted** sections of the following eight components of the WMIS described in the July draft MERR:

i. Management questions and indicators

ii. Objectives and performance standards

iii. Prioritization criteria and rationale

iv. Identification of priorities

v. Standards for data quality, including precision and accuracy

vi. Preferred study designs and statistical analysis

vii. Preferred performance measures and protocols, and

viii. Data management, data sharing, and reporting.

Work thru Habitat/Cover Types, identify and associate categories with WMIS as it applies to the listed MERR/WAC performance standards and measures. Consider linkages of different projects and measures/DFC/Reference Sites/Ecological Indicators at the basinwide scale and utilize existing documents and methods (M.

Berger, NHI, UWMEP, reference sites, etc.)

Organize the Habitat/Cover Types and species response indicators identified in projects basin-wide and WMIS and collaboratively decide the roll-up process for WMIS that addresses the MERR Plan.

future ways to determine successful wildlife mitigation.
